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**SUBJECT: COMMUNITY RELATIONS POLICY**

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In the belief that the introduction of a mining operation into a community can create significant benefits for the people of that community as well as for the shareholders, Kimber will work towards a sustainable future for the communities in which it operates. To this end Kimber will endeavour to develop and maintain a mutually beneficial working relationship with the people of those communities and to be a responsible corporate citizen.

Kimber will:

- 1 Respect the people of the communities (the “local people”) in which it operates and their culture.
- 2 Keep the local people informed of plans and developments impacting the local community.
- 3 Listen to concerns expressed by the local people and, where practical, address those concerns.
- 4 Adhere to environmental and safety standards in accordance with corporate policies governing such matters.
- 5 Where practical, channel economic benefit to the community and its members.
- 6 Where skills and abilities match those required, endeavour to engage local people in employment.



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- 7 Facilitate employment of the local people by helping to provide training programs, where appropriate, that will allow them to obtain qualifications for mine-related occupations.
- 8 Work with the local people towards managing the impact of municipal growth and a larger local economy for the benefit of all residents.
- 9 Develop and maintain procedures for open two-way communication between the Company and the local community.
- 10 Where appropriate for addressing issues of local concern, form committees on which both Kimber and the community is represented.
- 11 Provide reasonable compensation to those who are adversely affected by the activities of the Company.
